

## VISIT TO RIPLEY CASTLE, FOLLOWED BY LUNCH AT THE BOAR'S HEAD, RIPLEY Wednesday 30 September 2015

Sir Thomas Ingilby's talk in April gave us an insight into the running of his Estate. Ripley is a conservation area and modelled on a French village. We have arranged for a group guided tour of the Castle, commencing at 11.30 am, lasting approximately one hour and fifteen minutes. This will be followed by a soup and sandwich lunch at **The Boar's Head**- drinks not included - some 100 metres from the Castle, at 1.15pm. It will be served in a private room to the right of the Reception area. Following this, your ticket entitles you to regain entry to the gardens if you wish.

As this is a local visit, please make your own arrangements for travel to Ripley which is three miles north of Harrogate, just off the A.61. At the large roundabout, just before the village, follow the signs for Ripley. Park on the field prior to, or in, the village. For those with sat nav, the post code is HG3 3AY. Please meet in the courtyard of the Castle by 11.20 am. I have been asked to make sure that all our visitors remain outside until tickets have been distributed.

The cost will be £17.50 each for the Castle tour, lunch and access to the gardens. If you are an HHA member the cost will be £8.50. Please complete the slip below and return to me, together with your cheque made payable to **Linton Antique Society**, at the address on the form, by 15 August
